/// WHAT IS A TEMPORARY DEMONSTRATION PROJECT?

The purpose of this temporary demonstration project is to provide a low-cost opportunity to test the effectiveness of proposed design alternatives, firsthand, as well as collect feedback from the community. The following will be temporarily installed at the demonstration project:

- » **Curb Extensions** aid in traffic calming and shorten crossing distances for pedestrians and cyclists. Additionally, this reclaimed space creates opportunities for other amenities such as expanded sidewalks, plantings, and art installations.
- » **Sharrows** remind motorists to watch for and share the roadway with cyclists.
- » **A Multi-Use Path** provides a safe, off-road connection between the KIPP Primary and Middle schools, Tivoli Preserve, and the proposed **Patroon Creek Greenway** (see below for more information).

The goal of The Patroon Creek Greenway Feasibility Study is to identify a feasible, multi-use trail connection from Albany's Hudson River waterfront west to Six Mile Waterworks Park. This approximately 9 mile trail would provide a much needed east-west connection for cyclists, pedestrians, and other forms of active transportation in the City of Albany.
